## Egypt "Gift of the Nile" Assessment

Herodotus said that "Egypt is the gift of the Nile." Students will create a product that demonstrates their understanding of the ways the Nile River impacted Egypt's development using the categories of agriculture, natural resources, and transportation.

## **Product Choices:**

<u>Write a 5 paragraph essay</u> with summarizing paragraph graphic organizer. Essay will include at least one example from each category of the class notes with explanation as to how it impacted Egypt's development. (Introduction and conclusion expected.)

<u>Draw a map of the Nile River region</u>. Label on map at least one example from each category of the class notes with explanation as to how it impacted Egypt's development.

<u>Create a diorama</u>, no bigger than a shoebox or cereal box. Diorama must include at least one example of each category from class notes with explanation as to how it impacted Egypt's development.

<u>Design a comic strip</u> in which the characters demonstrate at least one example from each category from class notes with explanation as to how it impacted Egypt's development.
