Types of Governments

Purpose of gov't: To keep order, to protect society

<u>Theocracy:</u> "God(s)" rule(s), or his/her "representatives" (Priests are ruling)

Theocracies today: Vatican City, Iran (?)

<u>Monarchy: Rule by one with Absolute Power</u> <u>Hereditary</u> (passed down through generations) "<u>Divine Right</u>" (appointed by god(s))

Called "king," "queen," "sultan," "emperor," etc.

Absolute monarchies today: Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Oman, Brunei, Swaziland

Constitutional monarchies today: <u>With a strong monarch</u>: Bahrain, Bhutan, Jordan, Kuwait, Liechenstein, Monaco, Morocco, Tonga, UAE <u>With a weak monarch</u>: Andorra, the 16 countries of the British Commonwealth*, Belgium, Cambodia, Denmark, Japan, Lesotho, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Thailand

* UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Belize, Papua New Guinea, St. Kitts & Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent & the Grenadines, Solomon Islands, Tuvalu, Bahamas, Barbados, Antigua & Barbuda, Grenada, Jamaica
